

In March, Sea and Sky Trio will celebrate the release of our new cd, performing some of our favourites from the album. For our finale, Jane Coop returns, along with a fantastic cellist new to Vetta audiences, John Friesen, to perform another great Beethoven Trio – the Archduke. Enjoy!
